The Senate Budget Committee today released a current tally of congressional legislation related to Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Enacted hurricane-related relief is now more than \$103 billion.

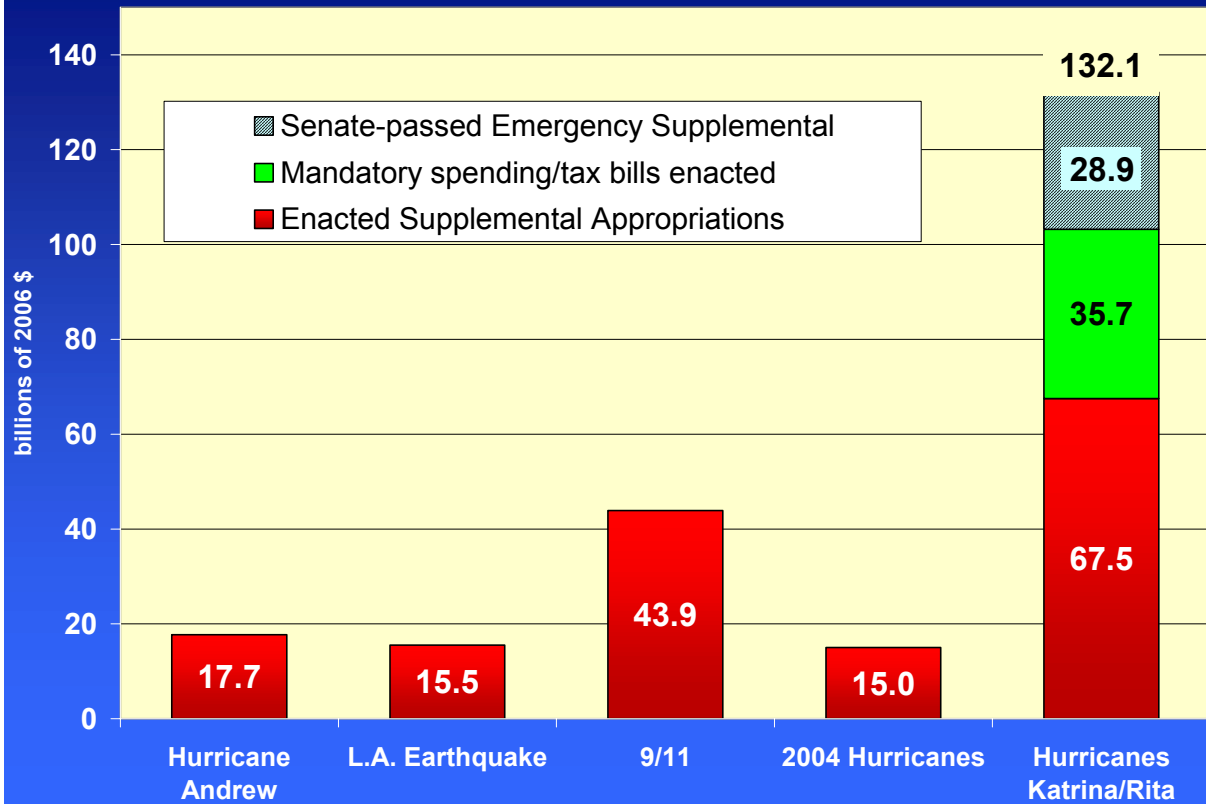
