Hawaii Earthquakes

HI CURRENT OPERATIONS

- Hawaii and Oahu County EOC 24/7 operations
- 2 Red Cross shelters established housing approximately 20 people
- Disaster Assistance Recovery Centers being set up in affected areas
- Resolving transportation issues remains top priority
- Kawaihae Harbor closed
- Damage assessments ongoing
- Structural engineers performing assessments of critical infrastructure in Hawaii County

FUTURE OPERATIONS

- Conduct debris clearance operations on highways and roads
- Restore commercial airports and ports to full operational capacity
- Continue to conduct damage assessments on Islands of Hawaii, Maui, and Oahu
- Provide community public health assistance
- Continue to conduct structural inspections of dams and buildings

NG CURRENT OPERATIONS

- 11 ARNG SAD - 9 providing HI County Civil Defense Agency and 2 working in a transport capacity
- NGB LNO on site at Diamondhead, Honolulu, HI - JOC
- J6 JET on standby
- ISISCS (Interim Satcom Incident Site Communications Set) is operational and on standby

FUTURE OPERATIONS

- Continue to provide assistance as requested

FEMA CURRENT OPERATIONS

- FEMA ERT (Emergency Response Team) activated and team of 25 arrived on Oahu 16 OCT
- FEMA JFO (Joint Field Office) will be established at Fort Shafter

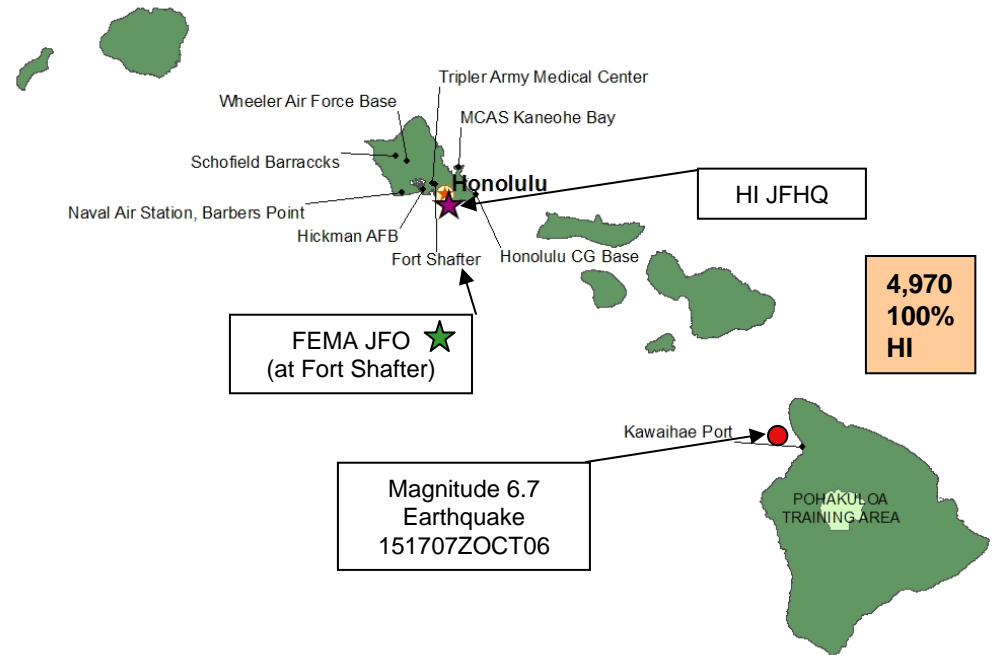
FUTURE OPERATIONS
