1122 PROGRAM

This program allows State and local governments to purchase new items suitable for counter-drug activities through federal procurement channels. Participating State and local agencies utilizing the 1122 Program can achieve cost savings of 10%-80% on their purchases of law enforcement related equipment.

1122 Program History

The National Defense Authorization Act of FY 1994 authorizes State and local agencies to purchase law enforcement related equipment suitable for counter-drug activities through Federal Government procurement channels. Using the 1122 Program, State and local agencies can purchase items through three separate federal sources:

- n Defense Logistics Agency (DLA)**
- n Department of the Army (DA)**
- n General Services Administration (GSA)**

AIRCARD

The Defense Energy Support Center AIRCARD Program enables law enforcement agencies (LEAs) to obtain aviation fuel, fuel related supplies, and ground services at favorable government rates. For example, the commercial price for jet fuel type A at Sacramento Mather Airport is currently \$3.75 per gallon, but with the AIRCARD the price is \$2.55. LEAs must be certified in the 1122 Program to participate.

Items and Services available through AIRCARD

- **Aviation Fuel**
- **Fueling Fees (Callout, Flowage, Overtime, Refueling, De-fueling, etc.)**
- **Ground equipment (stairs, start carts, baggage conveyer belt)**
- **Supplies (maps, navigational aids)**
- **Aircraft fees (landing, ramp, & parking)**
- **Aircraft housekeeping or cleaning services (trash collection, lavatory servicing)**
- **Security Services**
