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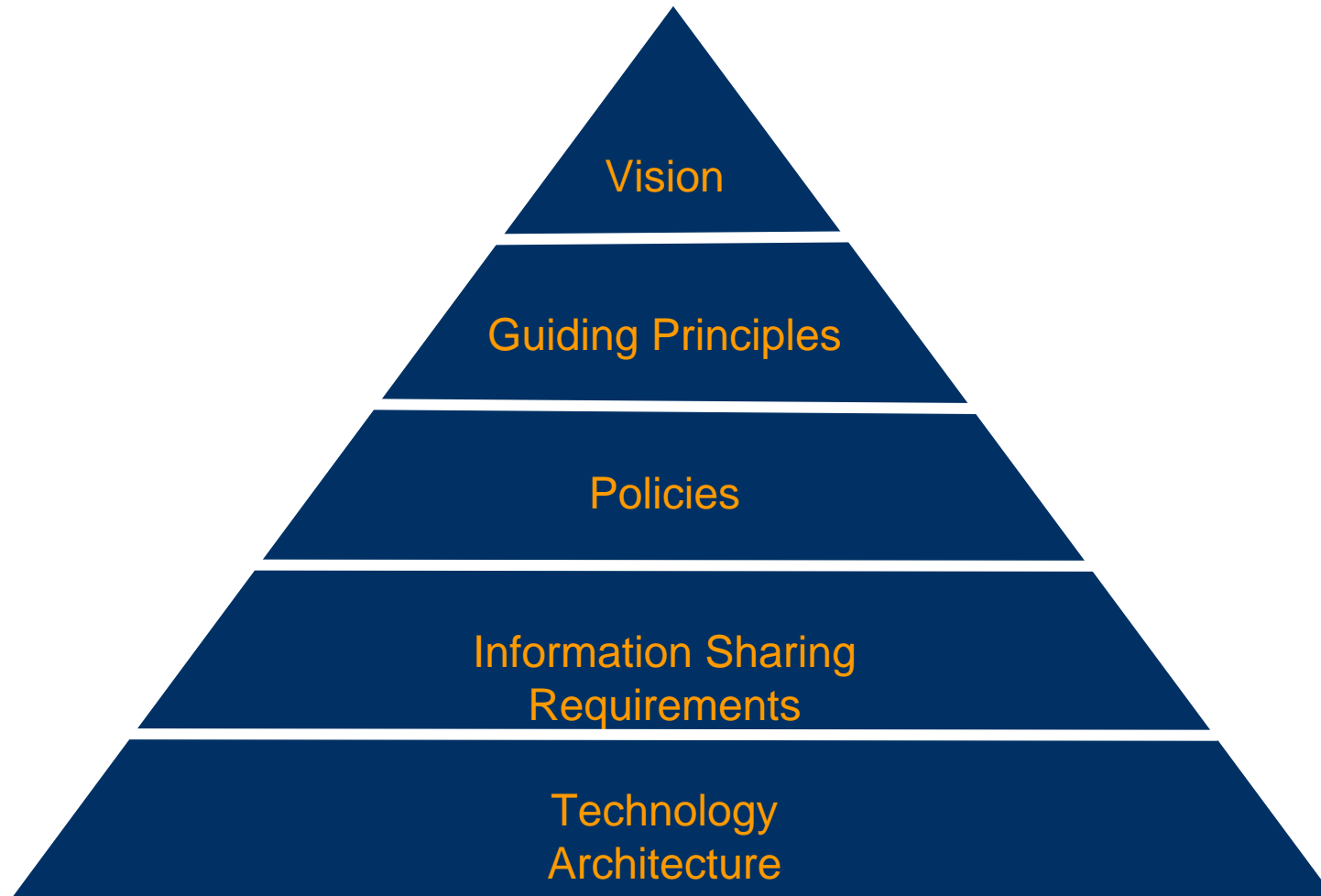
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Elements of the LEISP strategy.



DOJ will implement internal sharing policies, and...



DOJ Internal Policies on Information Sharing

- ◆ Commit to comprehensive, routine information sharing
- ◆ Protect the privacy of individuals by ensuring that individually identifiable information is not misused or inappropriately disclosed
- ◆ Present DOJ to local, state, tribal and federal law enforcement as a single information sharing entity
- ◆ Create shareable, tear-line versions of classified information

...will contribute to community-wide sharing policies.



Community-wide Information Sharing Policies

- ◆ Collaborate on information sharing initiatives
- ◆ Protect privacy
- ◆ Employ interoperability standards
- ◆ Use shared data responsibly
 - Protocols and procedures
 - Security
 - Training
 - Accountability



DOJ investments to execute the strategy will be guided by an IT architecture that supports information sharing.



Inter-Connectivity

- ◆ Connect DOJ with existing LE partners (e.g., NLETS, RISS) & the Homeland Security community
- ◆ Leverage and participate in existing local, regional, state & federal initiatives
- ◆ Coordinate DOJ architecture with partner architectures

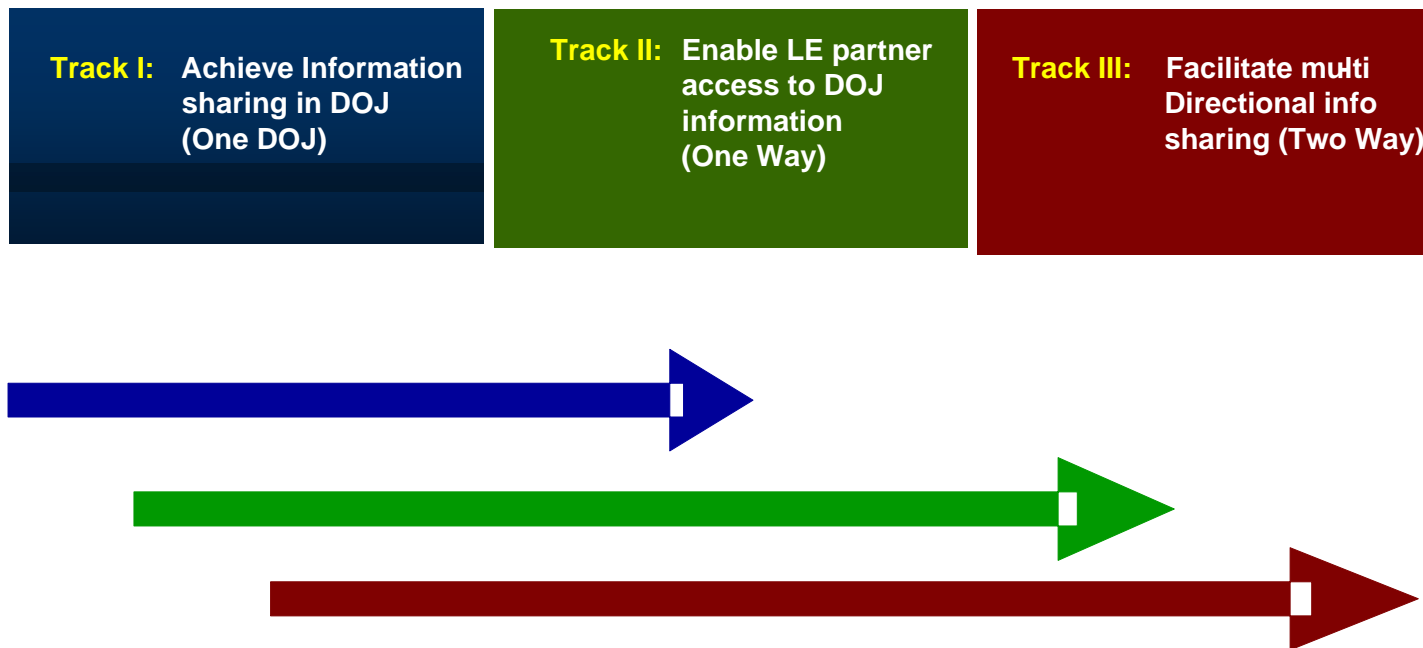
Standards

- ◆ Employ existing standards (e.g., GJXML, CJIS security practices)
- ◆ Participate in development of community-wide protocols and practices

Implementation of the strategy will be managed through three overlapping tracks.

Unified DOJ Information Sharing Practices

- ◆ DOJ information sharing polices
- ◆ Federal Uniform Crime Reporting processes
- ◆ DOJ-wide participation in N-DEx and other information sharing programs

Consolidated Information Sharing Capabilities

- ◆ One Alert System
- ◆ One Pointer System
- ◆ One Counter-surveillance Reporting System
- ◆ Single, integrated email system
- ◆ Single data fusion model

Unified De-Confliction Processes

- ◆ Develop DOJ-wide protocols and procedures to coordinate & de-conflict investigative activities
