# Significant Earthquake Activity



## M 7.5 – Alaska

- Occurred 3:58 a.m. EST on Saturday, January 5, 2013
  - 63 miles west of Craig, AK & 208 miles south of Juneau, AK
  - Depth of 6.2 miles
- USGS issued a Green PAGER alert:
  - 11k-15k residents exposed to Moderate-to-Strong shaking
  - Low likelihood of damage or injury
- West Coast & Alaska Tsunami Warning Center determined:
  - No Pacific-wide tsunami threat; however, regional tsunami imminent
  - Tsunami Warning for coastal areas of British Columbia & SE AK
- Small tsunami observed (< 1/2 foot) in southeast Alaska
- No reported damage or injuries; no requests for FEMA or US assistance
- All Tsunami Warnings/Advisories lifted
- FEMA Region X briefly activated to Level III; now at Watch/Steady State


