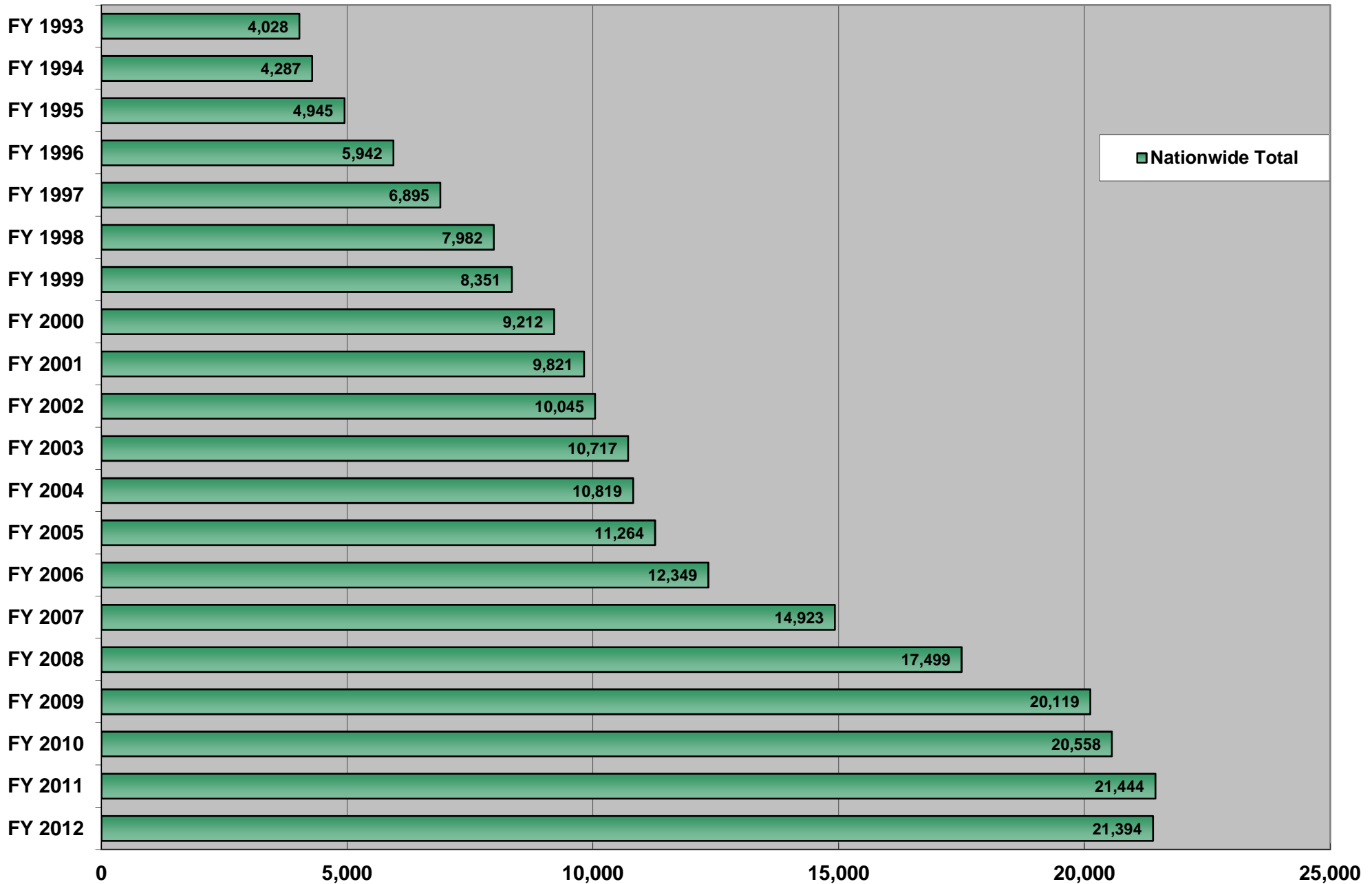

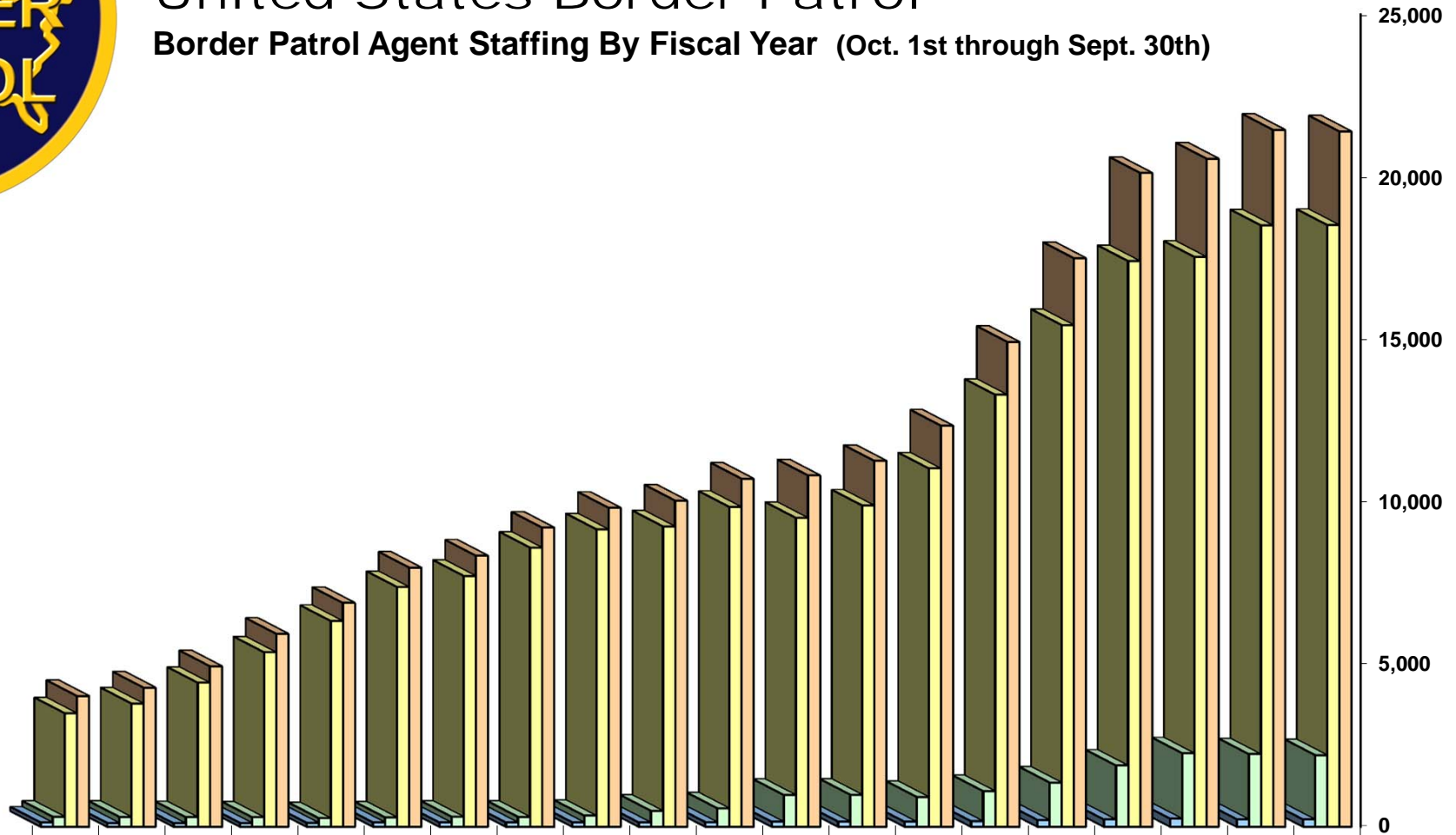
Border Patrol Agent Staffing by Fiscal Year (Oct. 1st through Sept. 30th)
