HSIN-Intel



Overview

The Homeland Security Information Network (HSIN) is a national secure and trusted Web-based portal for information sharing and collaboration among federal, state, local, tribal, territorial, private sector, and international partners engaged in the homeland security mission. HSIN is made up of a growing network of sites, called Communities of Interest (COI). COIs are organized by state organizations, federal organizations, or mission areas, such as emergency management, law enforcement, critical sectors, and intelligence. Users can securely share information and products within their communities or with other communities as needed. HSIN provides secure, real-time collaboration tools, including a virtual meeting space, instant messaging, and document sharing. HSIN also allows partners to work together instantly, regardless of their location, to communicate, collaborate, and coordinate.

HSIN-Intel is a COI focused on supporting the collaboration of fusion centers within the National Network of Fusion Centers, including the sharing of products and information. It is the primary vehicle for fusion centers and other key stakeholders to share sensitive but unclassified information. HSIN-Intel is a chartered and vetted community of intelligence analysts from the homeland security, intelligence, and law enforcement communities at all levels of government who share homeland security-related information and analyses on a daily basis in order to address threats to the homeland.

In order to make HSIN-Intel even more robust and user-friendly, a new section was created—called Partner Products—that allows users to easily find and access valuable products and resources, including analytic products, situational awareness products, guidebooks, and other critical resources, many of which were previously unavailable. HSIN-Intel minimum eligibility requirements include being a U.S. citizen; serving as a current employee (government or contractor personnel) of a federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial (SLTT) intelligence, law enforcement, criminal justice, emergency responder, or homeland security agency; and having an official government e-mail address. Members are validated and approved by fusion center key leaders, the HS SLIC Executive Board, and/or the HSIN-Intel Branch.
