





- Tropical storm-force winds extend outward up to 60 miles




Tropical Depression Fred - Advisory #30: (As of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- No significant change in strength forecast during next 48 hours



Tropical Depression Fifteen-E - Advisory #2:



- Forecast to become a tropical storm today; could become a hurricane by late Monday









Precipitation Forecast, 1 – 3 Day





El Niño conditions currently observed across Equatorial Pacific



- NOAA forecasts El Niño event will continue through the winter; weaken through the spring
- El Niño expected to peak this fall or early winter as a strong event
- Could be one of the stronger El Niño events in recorded history
- 3 strongest El Niño events occurred in 1972/73, 1982/83 and 1997/98
- All El Niño events are different, and produce variable impacts
- Positive correlation between El Niño events and increased tropical cyclone activity in the eastern Pacific basin (season lasts until Nov 30th)
- Even if drought stricken areas in the western U.S. receive above average precipitation this winter, it likely will not erase long term drought conditions







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2 – Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific


