Overview:


- A series of storm systems over the Pacific Northwest & Intermountain West has produced widespread precipitation across the region
- 5-day total precipitation could range from 6 to 12 inches, with isolated higher amounts

Impacts:

- No widespread evacuations, damage, fatalities or injuries reported
- Isolated residential flooding has occurred in low-lying areas
- Transportation impacts have been reported due to flooding and small mudslides
 - Local road closures have occurred
 - Amtrak service is suspended from Portland, OR to Vancouver, WA – expected to resume service later today
- Approximately 110,000 customers are without power across the region (as of 8:00am)
 - 72,000 in Washington
 - 28,000 in Oregon
- ARC Shelters: 3 open with 6 occupants (WA & OR)

Response:

- OR and WA State EOCs are monitoring the situation; no shortfalls reported
- FEMA Region X remains at Normal Operations; Bothell MOC is monitoring
- No request for FEMA assistance is anticipated



Flooding – Pacific Northwest



Overview:

- A series of storm systems produced high winds & near record rainfall in western Washington and northwest Oregon
- Moderate to Major Flood Stage persist in western WA and the Yakima basin

Impacts:

- **One fatality was reported in Oregon;** no other fatalities or injuries reported
- **Local damage assessments continue in Washington and Oregon**
- Isolated flooding and small mudslides have **caused numerous road closures and rail service restrictions;** a portion of Interstate 5 was closed near Woodland, WA
- **Approx. 8k customers are without power across Region X (Peak was 110k)**
- Open Shelters/Occupants: OR - 2 w/5 occupants; WA - 4 w/5 occupants




- **SEOC is fully activated;** Governor declared a State of Emergency
- **National Guard personnel activated to support response activities**


Last 30 Day Percent of Normal Precipitation


River Flood Forecast



Significant River Flood Outlook




