# Earthquake Activity – Cushing, OK



## M5.0 – Cushing, OK

- At 8:44 pm EST on November 6, 2016, 2 miles west of Cushing, OK (population 7,826), at a depth of 3 miles
- MMI of VI (10k exposed strong shaking)
- Green PAGER alert (low likelihood of casualties/damage)
- No reports of injuries or fatalities
- Preliminary reports of damage to multiple buildings downtown
- 40 residents evacuated from a senior living center (OK EOC)

## Response:

- Assessments ongoing
- OK EOC remains at normal operations
- FEMA Region VI RWC remains at Watch/Steady State
- No requests for FEMA assistance
